Lorry in bridge plunge fears

EMERGENCY services are currently dealing with an accident where a lorry is balancing precariously over the edge of a bridge.

The accident happened around 7.30pm on the Brent Eleigh road between Monks Eleigh and Sudbury close to the River Brett.

A spokesman for Suffolk police said the Polish lorry had left the road while on the bridge and half of it was now hanging over the main support.

He said the Environment Agency was called after it was discovered petrol was leaking into the river.

The road is expected to be closed all weekend.
