

Monks Eleigh Census of 1891

The census shows that there were 546 people living in Monks Eleigh on the night of the 1891 Census. 281 or 51.5% were male and 265 or 48.5% were female

The following tables show the numbers in each:

Occupation: The top occupation was 97 Farm Labourers, 16 Domestic Servants, 11 Farmers, 10 Receiving Parish Relief, 8 Carpenters and 7 Teachers.

Places of Birth: with 62% of villagers having been born in Monks Eleigh.

Surnames: with 36 Partridges, 33 Foskers, followed by Green, Hollox, Gage and Vince.

First Names: with John the most popular amongst the Men and Boys and Mary amongst the Women and Girls.
