The census shows that there were 564 people living in Monks Eleigh on the night of the 1901 Census. 282 or exactly half were male and 282 were female

Occupation: The top occupation was 67 Farm Labourers, 22 Horsemen working on farms, 9 Domestic Servants, 8 farmers, 8 Stockmen on Farms and 6 School Teachers.

Places of Birth: with 53% of villagers having been born in Monks Eleigh.

Surnames: with 31 Partridges, 31 Foskers, followed by Green, Bugg, Hollox, Butcher and Butcher.

First Names: with John the most popular amongst the Men and Boys and Mary amongst the Women and Girls.
